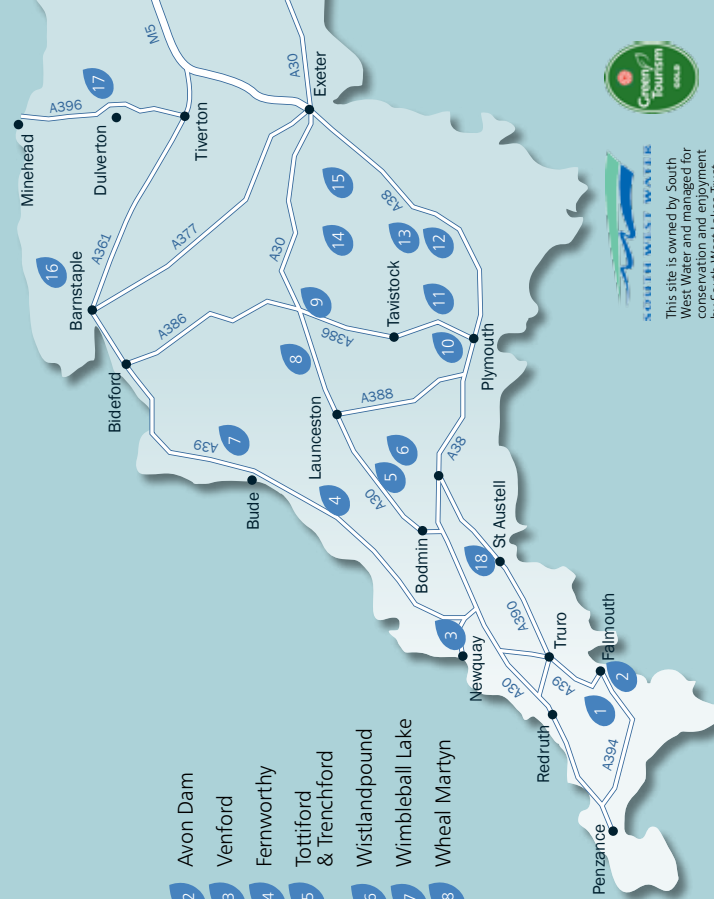

From the A30 Roadford Lake is signed between Launceston and Okehampton. Follow the brown tourism signs to the Lakeside entrance. Cross over the dam for the Outdoor + Active Centre, where the entrance is approximately 1/4 mile on the right.
